And we're rolling...

The greatest asset you have is the people you know- and the people to whom they will connect you.

First things first. Make a list of at least 100 people. Go ahead and make this list now–TODAY!

That way, you can hit the ground running.

(And, don't worry– your Upline will coach you "hands on" what to do with these names. For now, you need to make the list, though.)

A few tips as you begin:

First, list 25 people who you want to tell about this opportunity. These are people who immediately come to mind. They are friends and family who will lock arms with you– or might be people you believe would be great at this.

Second, after listing these people, move to the categories of other people on the following pages, highlighting names you know. You'll be surprised at how easy it is to contact these people (many times, it's easier to reach

out to them than the first group-because there's less emotion involved). And, many of them have been looking for an opportunity.

A few more important notes...

Don't prejudge anyone. There will be some people you think won't be a good fit, and others you think will. For various reasons.

Right now, just list everyone. You're going to see that a few people you think will knock it out of the park won't even be interested; others whom you think don't have a wing and a prayer will radically succeed. So, just make the list.

No judgments!

Alright?

You're not just looking for these people, you're looking for the people they can connect you to. Everyone you know has influence and knows people that you don't know. The person helping you train will talk with you more about this as you get started.

Think of people you know because of these roles, as well as people you know who have these roles. For instance, you may not have a plumber... but you may know a few people who are plumbers. You might not have a nanny, but you may know someone who is a nanny...

This list will continue growing. You'll be surprised how many "random" names will come to you at odd times. So, have a plan to jot names– on a note in your smartphone, on a piece of paper in your day-timer, whatever...

Alright, start writing... there's plenty of space here to start jotting notes.

You can always go back and make a "clean list" with contact info later!
